1. General Profile of the Institute

The activities of the Research Institute (hereinafter referred to as the "RI") are based on the main provisions of the Constitution of the Republic of Kazakhstan, regulatory legal acts of the authorized state body, in accordance with the Charter of the Turan-Astana University, corporate documents of the University, and the Regulations.

2. Results of the Three-Year Cycle (2023–2025)

In 2025, the Institute summarized the results of the completed three-year research cycle. At the Academic Council meeting on October 21, 2025, final reports for all projects were approved, and 11 scientific monographs were authorized. The council members noted significant progress achieved through effective research coordination and a well-established system of interdisciplinary interaction.

3. Key Scientific Results

The primary achievements of the Institute during the reporting period include the development of fundamental problems in philosophy, political science, and religious studies, as well as applied research on topical issues of social development. Particular attention was paid to the methodological foundations of social, political, and cultural processes in Kazakhstan. The Institute confirmed its status as a national intellectual center, ensuring a balance between scientific discovery, social values, and cultural continuity.

4. Objectives for 2026

At the Academic Council meeting on December 26, 2025, priority areas for further development were identified. The Institute will continue to strengthen its position as a leading humanitarian research platform, addressing the challenges of the digital age while preserving philosophical heritage and cultural traditions.
